

2012 AAM Annual Meeting Student and Professional Fellowships

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants for the Student Fellowship:

- must be full-time graduate students engaged in an exhibition-related course of study in the United States;
- must not have previously attended the AAM Annual Meeting.

Applicants for the New Museum Professional Fellowship:

- must be working in the museum field with less than five years museum work experience;
- must not have previously attended the AAM Annual Meeting.

Number of Awards and Amount

NAME will fund three fellowships (two students and one New Museum Professional) for the 2012 AAM Annual Meeting in Minneapolis. The fellowship will include conference registration, a \$500 travel stipend, and attendance at NAME events with a NAME mentor.

Recipients of the NAME Fellowship must:

Attend the NAME business meeting, evening event, and luncheon at the Annual Meeting.

Application

Eligible applicants should apply by sending a single PDF document that includes:

- Letter of interest (no more than two pages) which:
 - discusses your current course of study or work experience and career goals;
 - indicates how attendance to the AAM Annual Meeting will benefit you and your course of study or work;
 - states how critical the financial award would be to your ability to attend the conference.
- Current resume (no more than two pages).
- Letter of recommendation/support from an internship supervisor, work supervisor, or academic advisor (no more than two letters).
